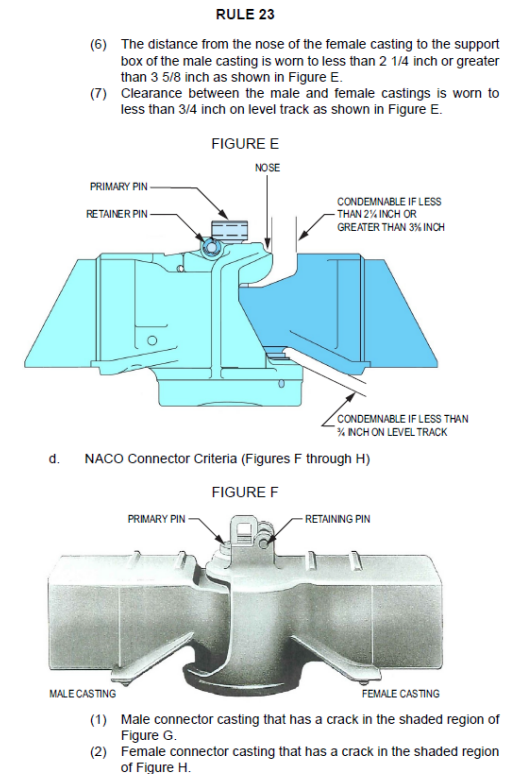
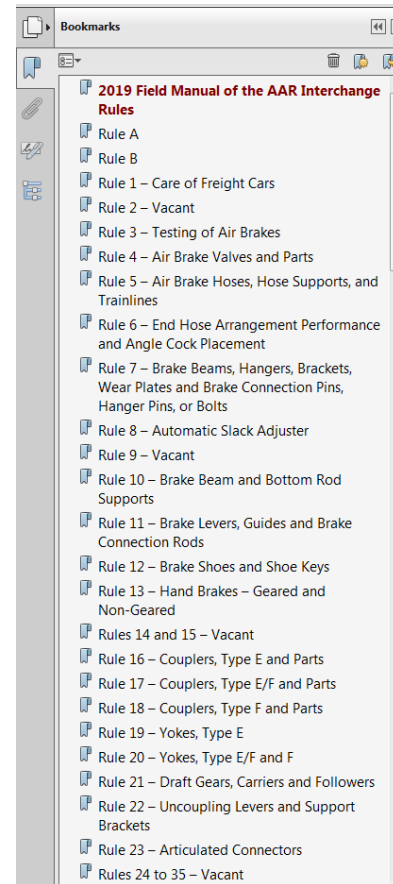
Additional Steps and Troubleshooting Tips

Disable Adobe global object security policy
This is often required for first-time users. To do this, open Adobe, click Edit > Preferences > JavaScript, uncheck the field Enable global object security policy, click OK.
Click 'Allow' on all communication prompts
This is required for authentication and is often only required for first-time users. If you accidentally clicked Do Not Allow or blocked the communication, see the next tip below.
Add the domain protectedpdf.com to your trusted sites
To do this, open Adobe, click Edit > Preferences > Trust Manager, click Change Settings, add host <https://protectedpdf.com> and click Allow.

- Cannot copy images or text (screen capture only)

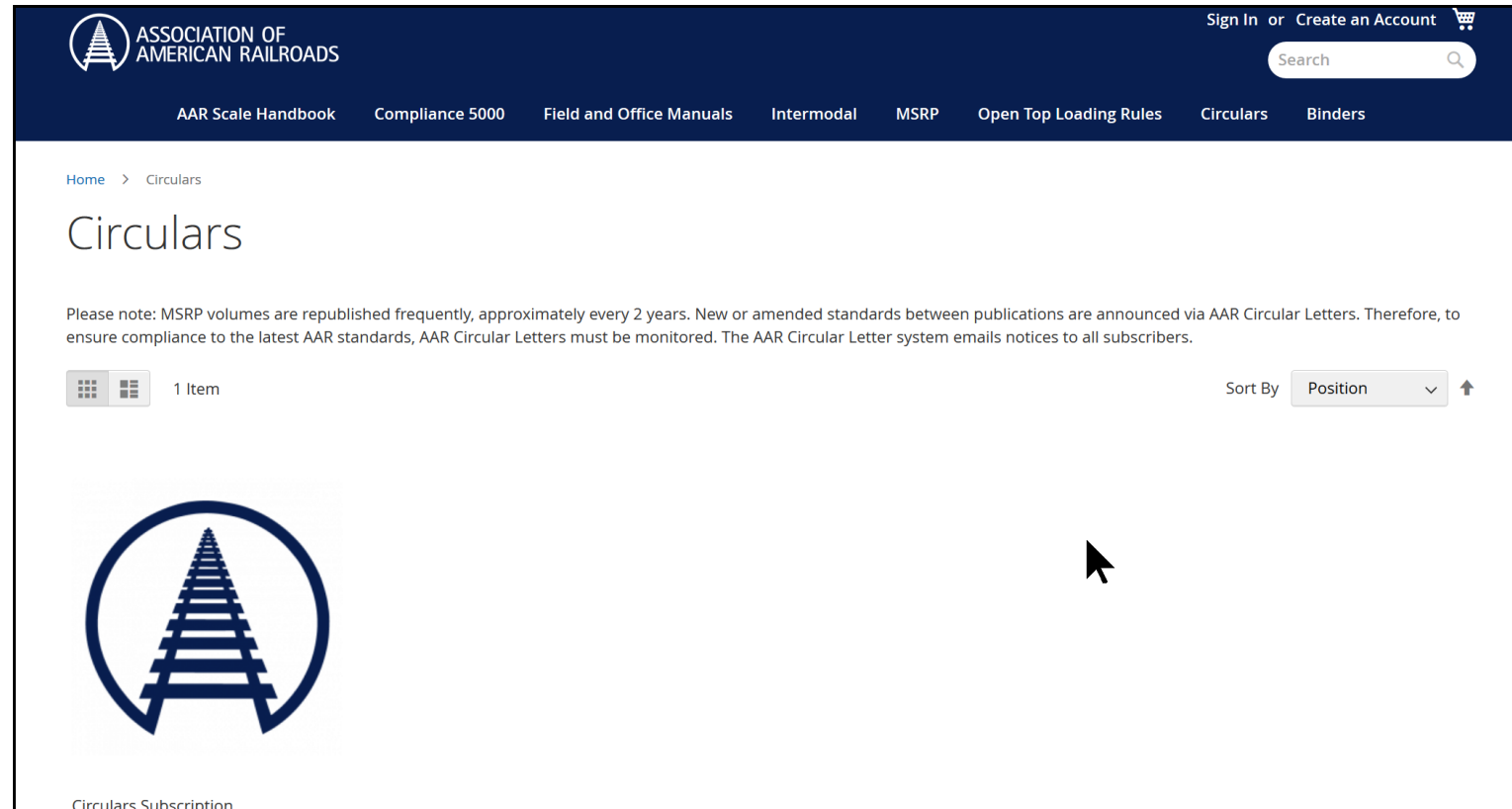
