

### GATX Lease Types

- Net Lease Lessee 100% responsible for locomotive during lease term. Unit must meet return conditions at the end of the lease before being accepted.
  - Nearly 100% of railroad leases are Net

- Lease with Maintenance (CM) GATX responsible for all required PM maintenance during the lease term and all unscheduled failures/repairs not caused by misuse of the locomotive.
  - Nearly 100% of industrial type leases are with maintenance



#### GATX Advantage – Fleet Makeup / Capital Investment

- Majority of locomotives part of 645E Engine family
- Extensive work scope of repairs/upgrades performed timely & consistently on all models
  - Requalification or remanufacture of major components
    - Rotating electrical equipment
    - Truck assemblies
    - Engine work; new main bearings
  - Re-work cabs
  - Minimum 2" Wheel Rim Thickness
